A Direct Debit is an instruction from you to your bank or building society authorising us to collect.

Advantages of Direct Debit

Paying by Direct Debit is less expensive; it saves travelling costs or stamps.

Direct Debit payers stay in control, you can cancel the Direct Debit at any time and choose from one of two alternate monthly payment dates.
