The Local Transport Plan Vision will set out the Council's policies and plans for all aspects of transport for the period 2021 to 2036.

The Council's vision to 2036 is to deliver and maintain a safe, reliable and joined-up transport system that connects new and existing communities, businesses, and commercial centres while providing leisure opportunities.

The vision will:

- Future-proof the transport network for new and emerging technology;
- Reduce social exclusion;
- Improve network resilience;
- Tackle climate change; and
- Reduce congestion and improve productivity.

## Vision

The Vision currently has three key themes; Environment, Social, and Technology.



### ENVIRONMENT

1

To protect and value our environment, decarbonising transport and protecting the local environment.

2

To provide safe, accessible alternative travel options to the car, giving health, air quality and carbon benefits.

3

To maximise the use of low cost renewable energy in operating and maintaining transport assets, minimising the Council's carbon footprint.

4

To provide greenways for walking and cycling, and green corridors with active biodiversity integral to the travel network.

5

To adapt to climate change and ensure that our transport networks are resilient to severe weather events.



### SOCIAL

1

To future proof travel networks to meet a more aged and diverse population whilst meeting the expectations of new generations

2

To provide a transport system which enables equal access for all. that can accommodate the travel needs of communities, commercial and retail businesses and the leisure sector.

3

To create well connected communities through enabling sustainable travel within and between existing and new housing.

4

To enhance the health and well-being of communities and their residents, through quality social infrastructure, and access to facilities, through alternatives to the car.

5

To reduce long commutes.



### TECHNOLOGICAL

1

To provide a future-proofed travel network that can assimilate emerging and new technologies such as Connected Autonomous Vehicles.

2

To provide an improved customer journey experience, through optimising use of Big Data.

3

To enable dynamic travel choices and optimised network performance, through the provision of borough wide availability of real-time travel information.

4

To allow all travellers to access information on travel opportunities through technological enhancements.

5

Connected council and alliance partners enabling value-added decision making on-site.

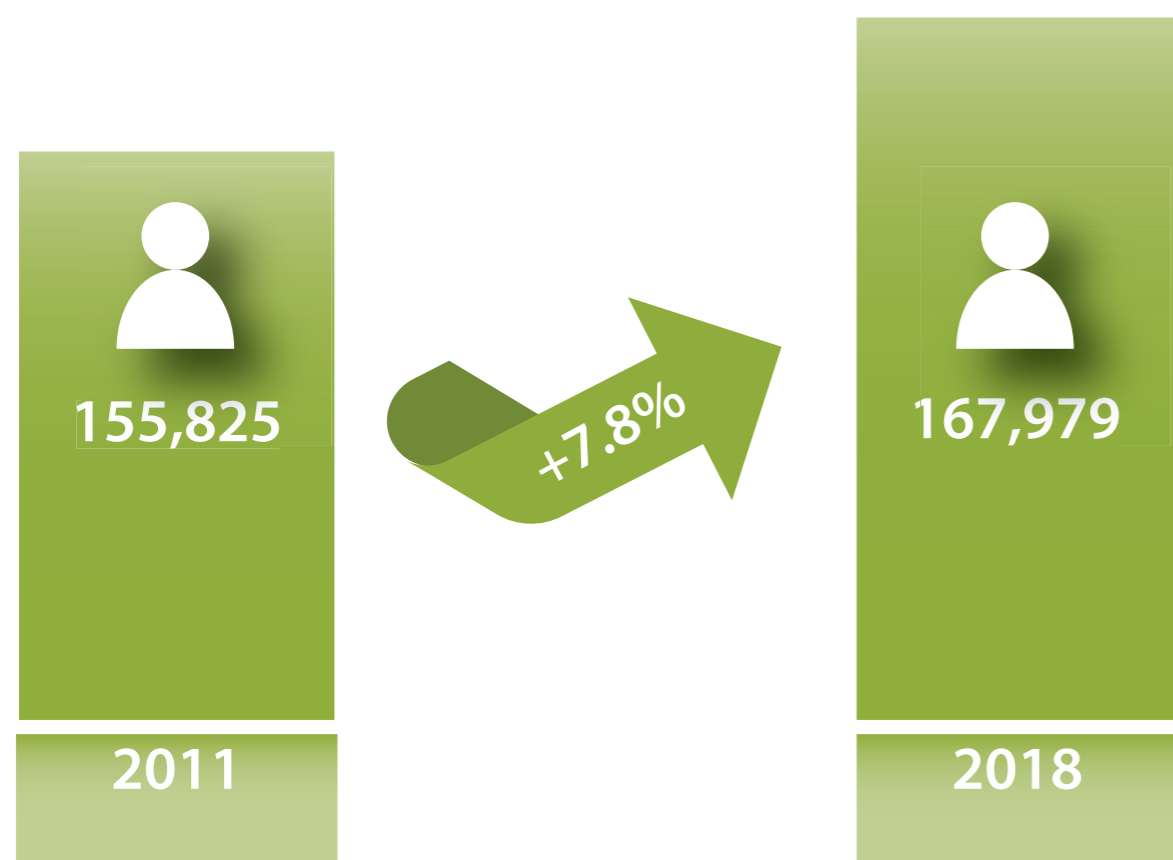

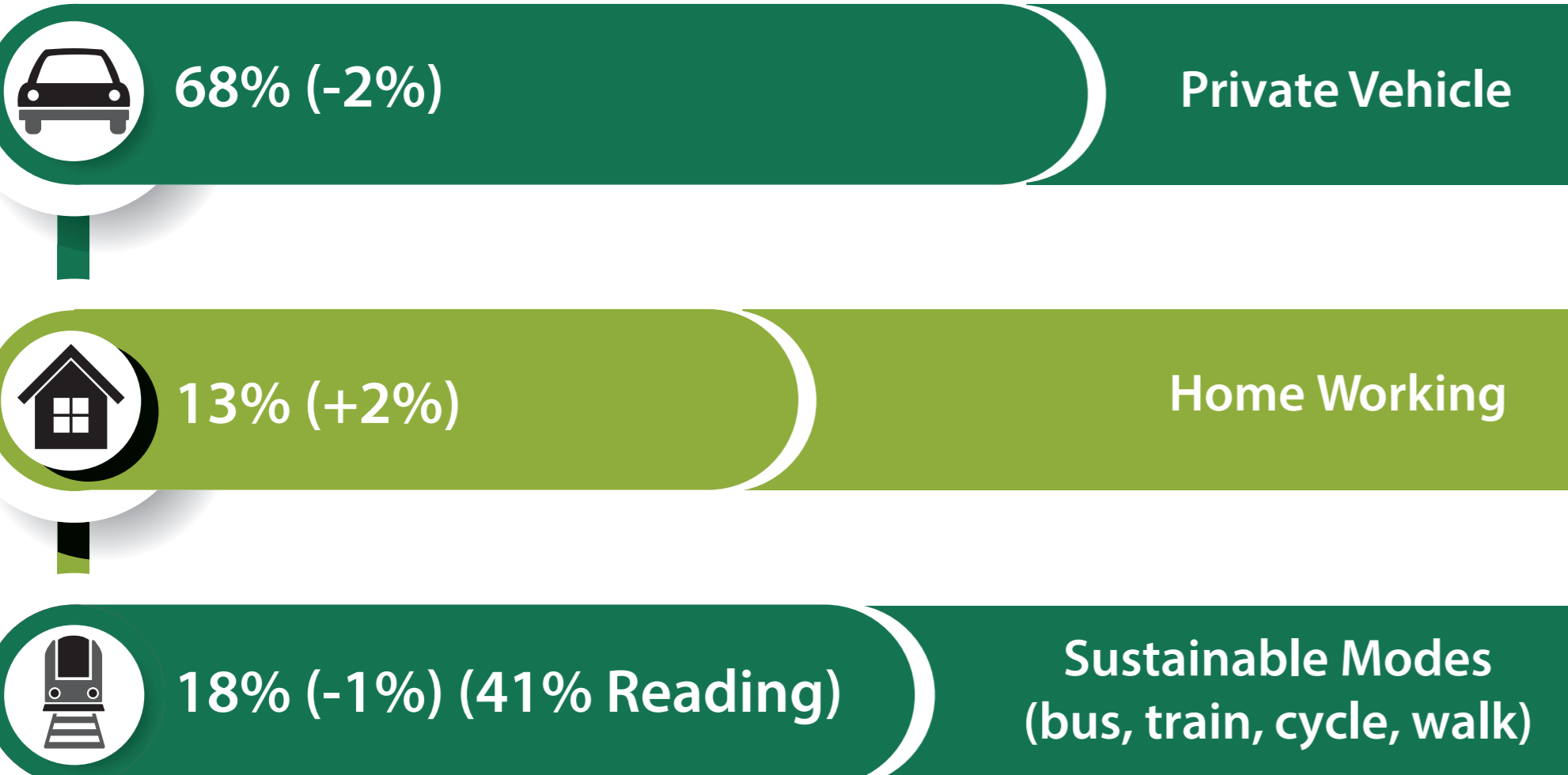
### Population Growth



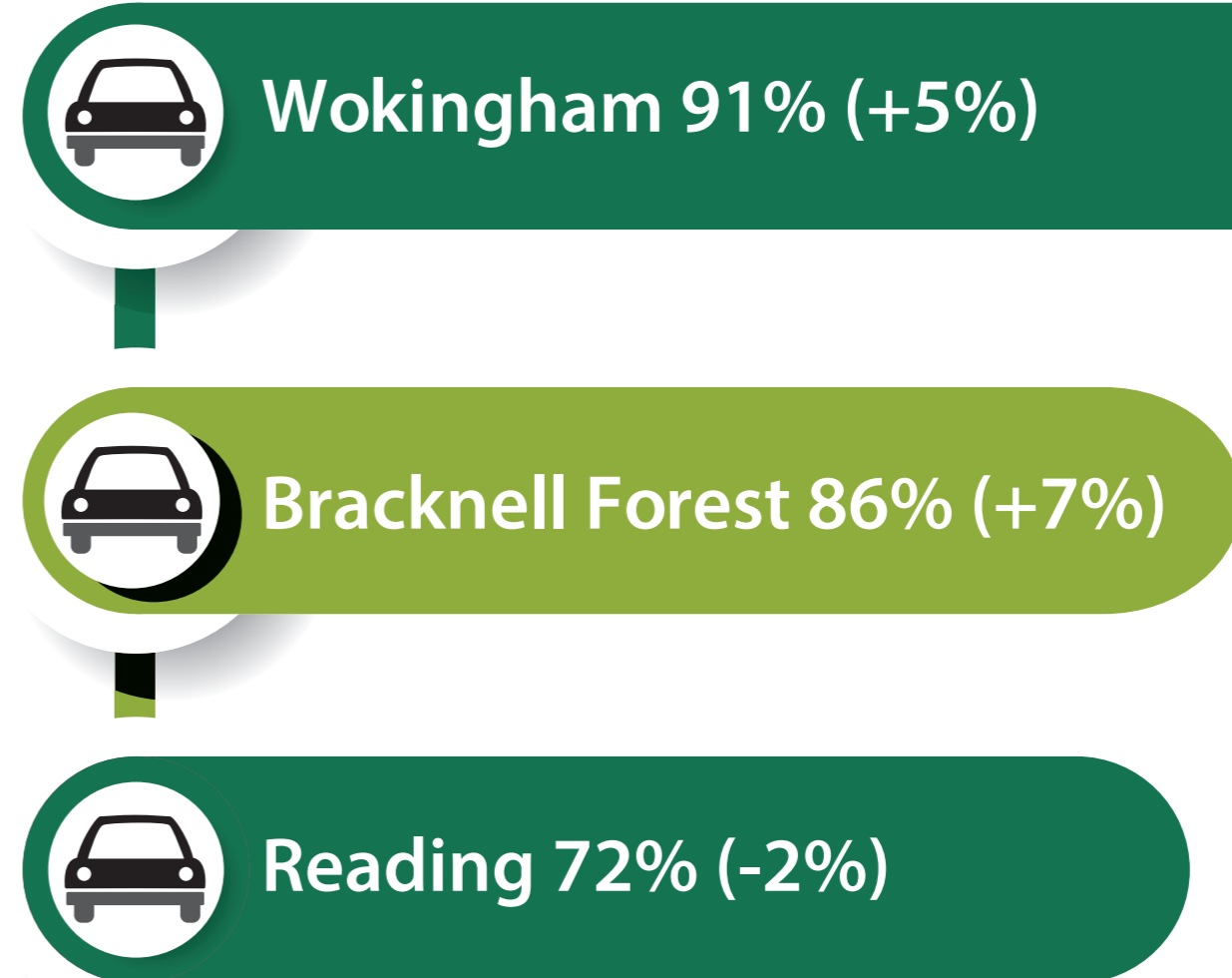
### Road Safety
