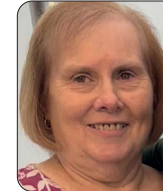

What type of ceremony is for you?

We are here to help you celebrate your love, but you can do that in lots of different ways.

A civil marriage or a civil partnership is available to all couples. It is also the only legal alternative to a religious marriage.

For a civil marriage or civil partnership to be legal, it must take place in any Register Office in England and Wales, or in a licensed venue, indoors or outdoors, and be conducted by a registrar from that district. As long as your ceremony includes the legally prescribed vows and no religious content, we encourage you to individualise your ceremony as you wish, with personal vows, readings, poems, music or other individual elements.

With a fantastic team of over 20 registrars in the Wokingham Borough, and history dating back to 1837, there is very little we can't help with when it comes to getting you married or civil partnered.

If you have already married or had a civil partnership but wish to celebrate the occasion with friends and family, we also offer a range of non-legally binding ceremonies to suit you – a wedding celebration ceremony, a renewal of vows, or a commitment ceremony. Likewise, if you wish to celebrate in a venue that isn't licensed, we can lead your celebration ceremony, perhaps even combining it with a visit to the Register Office to tie the legal knot beforehand.

Getting Married

Whether your wedding is a huge celebration, a simple ceremony to put a seal on a long-term relationship, a legal marriage before you head abroad for a larger ceremony, or you are having a religious blessing later – we will make sure your ceremony suits you as a couple.

The first step is to decide where you want your marriage ceremony to take place. We have a Ceremony Room at the Register Office in Wokingham, plus many licensed venues to suit all styles and budgets. A list of all our licensed venues and links to their websites can be found on pages 26 and 27, or on our website.

If you are marrying in the Wokingham Ceremony Room or Wokingham Register Office, the venue and the registrars can be booked together directly with us. If you decide on a licensed venue, please contact them directly to check their availability, before contacting us to make a booking for the registrars to attend.

You can book our services for any date in the current or next two financial years. Our fees increase annually at the beginning of each financial year. When you book your ceremony, you pay the fee that is current at the time of booking. We have several teams of registrars working, especially on popular days and times of the year, so will always do our best to accommodate your chosen date and time. Do of course get in touch with us as soon as possible for best availability. For our fees and our booking request form, please see our website.

Before getting married, you will both be required to give notice of your intention to marry at your local register office and more information about this can be found on pages 11 and 12.



Forming a Civil Partnership

For more information about whether a marriage or a civil partnership is right for you, please see the information on the government website.

Civil partnerships are available to opposite sex and same sex couples and offer a legal alternative to marriage.

You can form your partnership in any way you choose – from a simple signing of the documents with two witnesses, to a larger scale celebration. Your first step is to decide where you would like your ceremony to take place. We have a Ceremony Room at the Register Office in Wokingham, plus many licensed venues to suit all styles and budgets. A list of all our licensed venues and links to their websites can be found on pages 26 and 27, or on our website.

If you choose to form your partnership in the Wokingham Ceremony Room or the Register Office in Wokingham, the venue and the registrars can be booked together directly with us. If you decide on a licensed venue, please contact them directly to check their availability, and then contact us to make a booking.

You can book our services for any date in the current or next two financial years. Our fees increase annually at the beginning of each financial year. When you book your ceremony, you pay the fee that is current at the time of booking. We have several teams of registrars working, especially on popular days and times of the year, so we will always do our best to accommodate your chosen date and time. For our fees and our booking request form, please see our website.

Before forming your partnership, you will both be required to give notice of your intent to form a civil partnership at your local register office and more information about this can be found in this brochure on page 11 and 12.

While the perfect option for many couples, it is recommended that you ensure a civil partnership is right for you. In the UK the relationship between couples in a civil partnership is recognised legally in the same way as a married couple. However, if one of you is a foreign national or you plan to live abroad, the local laws of that country should be established to ensure your partnership will be recognised there. For opposite sex couples forming a civil partnership, there is no option to change your partnership to a marriage at a future date.

Ceremonies at the Wokingham Ceremony Room and Register Office

Alongside the range of licensed venues in the Wokingham Borough, we offer marriage and civil partnership ceremonies seven days a week.

Our ceremony room is in the older part of the Civic Offices which is the Old Rectory, with its high ceilings, ornate cornices and a stunning chandelier.

It offers an alternative to couples wishing to have a smaller, less formal, wedding ceremony.

The room holds up to 28 people, including children, photographers and the couple.

The Wokingham Register Office is available for statutory weddings and civil partnerships. It is in a working office with very limited availability and accommodates the couple and two witnesses only.

Booking Your Registrars

Once you have chosen your venue and preferred date, please complete the booking form on our website, or phone us on 0118 974 6000 (option 3).

When we speak with you, we will discuss the next steps, confirm our availability, make the booking, and take full payment.

We will confirm the booking by email, sending a confirmation letter, and more information about what will happen next. Most importantly

if you are marrying or forming a civil partnership we will advise you that the next step is to give legal notice. Once your booking is in place and the clock is ticking towards your big day, do get in touch with us at any time if we can help with anything.

Giving Notice

Before you can get married or form a civil partnership, you will need to give notice.

What is giving notice?

Giving notice is a legal requirement before you can get married or form a civil partnership. You and your partner will both need to prove that you are 'free' to marry, or form a civil partnership. This can mean proving you are old enough, that you are legally divorced or widowed, that you are not closely related, or that you have the right visas to marry if you are from outside the UK.

Without giving notice, you cannot legally marry or form a civil partnership, so it's really important to get booked in!

Do I need to have my ceremony booked?

No, you do not need to have your ceremony booked to give your notice.

However, you need to be certain on where you would like to have your wedding or civil partnership.

Your notice is only valid for one venue. So, if you decide to get married or form your civil partnership at a different venue, you will need to give notice again.

How long will my notice be valid for?

Your notice will be valid for 12 months, from the date that you give your notice. So, if for example, you gave notice on the 1st February 2026, your notice will be valid until the 1st February 2027.

When do I give notice?

You will need to give notice at least 29 days before the date of your ceremony, and can give notice anywhere up to a year before the date. We usually recommend around 4 to 6 months before the date of your ceremony.

Where do I give notice?

Your notice appointment will need to take place at your local register office. You will need to have been living at this address for at least 8 consecutive days.

If one or both of you is from outside the UK, then you must give notice together at a register office in the district where at least one of you lives.

Can I give notice online?

No, you must attend an appointment in person at your local register office.

How much does the appointment cost?

Giving notice at the Register Office currently costs £46.50 per person. If a Home Office immigration referral is necessary, the fee is £63. An additional charge may apply if you have a previous divorce that was granted in a country outside the United Kingdom.

What documents will I need to bring with me?

There are certain documents that you will need to take to your notice appointment.

If you are unsure of what to take with you, contact the Register Office you have booked your appointment with.

If you do not have the right documents with you when giving notice, you may need to rebook your appointment and pay the fee again. These documents come under three sections:

- Proof of Identity, Age and Nationality
- Proof of Residence
- Proof you are legally free to marry/form a civil partnership

If one or both of you is from outside the UK, you may be asked to bring additional documents with you.

Proof of your Identity, Nationality and Age

- Valid passport
- British Birth certificate (If you're born after 1st January 1983, you will need to bring your mother's birth certificate too)
- Any change of name documents If you are an EU/EEA or Swiss National and have settled status, pre-settled status or a pending application, you will need to provide a share code.

Proof of Residence

- UK Driving Licence
- Bank statement (no older than one month)
- Utility bill (no older than 3 months)
- Council Tax Bill (the most recent bill, no older than a year).

Proof you are legally free to marry/ form a civil partnership

- Decree Absolute
- Death Certificate
- Foreign Divorce Documents
- Translation of foreign divorce documents

If you are using documents where your names are different, you will need to show something to link these documents together.

For example, if you have a decree absolute in one name, and your passport or birth certificate is in another, we will need to see your previous marriage certificate.

What to do if you are a foreign national?

Foreign nationals are defined as people who are not British Citizens, Irish Citizens and who have not been granted EU Settled Status (EUSS) or have a pending application for EUSS submitted before 30 June 2021.

If you or your partner are a foreign national, you must give notice together in the registration district which one or both of you live.

If you are a foreign national, you will also need to bring evidence of your settled status in England and Wales. This can be shown with the following:

- Indefinite Leave to Remain/Enter or Marriage Visa, Fiancé visa or Civil Partnership visa.
- If you do not have either of these, your notice will be referred to the home office. This can extend your notice period to 70 days.

Will my Notice be referred if I am in the UK on a work visa?

Yes, your notice will still be referred to the Home Office. Unless you have a Marriage Visa, Fiancé visa or Civil Partnership visa, Indefinite Leave to Remain/Enter, then your notice will be referred.

Run-up and on the day:

In advance of the ceremony, please complete your ceremony details form sent at the time of booking. This helps us incorporate the vows you have chosen and helps you communicate other elements of the ceremony that are important to you too. We will use this to create your own personalised script which we then pass to your registrar to use on the day.

Please remember, our team of registrars is available to answer any questions and soothe any nerves!

Pre-ceremony appointment:

We can arrange for you to have an appointment with one of our registrars to discuss what will happen at your wedding. We will go through the script and even practice your vow words. You will also have the opportunity to ask any questions. This appointment is held over Teams and a small fee is charged, please see website.

Meeting with the registrars before the ceremony:

We will guide you through the whole process on the day. In advance of the ceremony we will see you both, either together or individually as you choose. This will be privately away from your guests and we will ask you to confirm the legal details. We will also offer you some last minute reassurance. We ask that you are ready in good time, so that we do not have to compromise the content of your ceremony.

During the Ceremony:

We will guide you through the whole ceremony. During a marriage ceremony, we will ask you to repeat your legal declaratory and contracting vows after us, so there is no need to remember anything or feel too nervous. You can also choose extra vow words for the exchange of rings and/or write your own personal vows or promises.

We love to hear the story of how you met and about important people in your lives, so there is a chance to include that as part of the ceremony. We want you to have a ceremony as individual as you are.

For a civil partnership, there are no legally prescribed vows but you can read aloud the legal statement, and include your own vows which can be read out or repeated after the registrar. We welcome your own choice of music, poems, readings or other personal elements. Likewise if you wish to keep things very simple, just let us know.

If you want some extra symbolism in your ceremony we can also do that. Ring warming or sand pouring are just two examples, and if you would like to have a religious blessing or pagan ritual we can hand over to the person performing it at the end of your ceremony.

Readings/Poems/Songs:

Readings are a wonderful way of personalising your ceremony and up to 3 can be incorporated into your ceremony. It can be very special to choose someone meaningful to you to read these.

We have a selection of our team's favourite readings to share with you on our website, but there are many readings and poems available elsewhere online.

If not one of our suggestions, then please share your readings with us in advance, so we can confirm they are suitable (to make sure they are not religious or offensive), and to ensure we have a copy with us on the day.

Music:

Music really adds to the atmosphere and can reflect your personalities perfectly. From a string quartet or a harp to your favourite rock tune, as long as it is not overtly religious in nature, or offensive anything goes as far as we are concerned!

Exchanging Rings:

Many couples choose to exchange rings to seal the deal. It can be nice to include a loved family member, best man, friend, bridesmaid/page boy to present these during the ceremony, but you can also have them with you, or on the table at the front during the ceremony.

Personal Vows:

If you wish to write your own vows and read/say them to each other, you are welcome to do so, and this can be a very special moment in your ceremony. We can present them to you to read at the right moment. If you don't wish to share them with each other before, then feel free to send them to us separately in advance.



Photography and Social Media:

You are welcome to bring professional photographers and videographers to our ceremony room and our licensed venues. We know how important it is to capture the essence of your celebration. We will always do our best to work with them to ensure they get the best shots. Likewise, if you choose friends and family to take photographs, they are welcome to do so.

If you would prefer no photos or any post on social media, just let us know and we can announce that at the start of the ceremony.

Live Stream the Ceremony:

If you have family or friends who live abroad or who are not well enough to attend the ceremony in person, you can request to live-stream the ceremony to them.

Witnesses:

The minimum number of guests you can have with you is your 2 witnesses. For all ceremonies, please select 2 guests, who must be able to understand English and have understood what has taken place. Witnesses should be 18 or older, they do not require ID.

Certificates:

Following your ceremony we take all the legal paperwork back to the office. Your legal certificates will be created and posted to you within a few days of the ceremony. If you require additional certificates to those purchased at the time of booking, please email us in advance of the ceremony. Extra copies are always available after the event too.

Celebration Ceremonies

A celebration ceremony does not hold legal status, but is a popular and symbolic way of celebrating your relationship or recent marriage.

You might choose this type of ceremony for a variety of reasons. Perhaps you wish to celebrate your relationship publicly without a legal obligation. You may have had a small legal ceremony elsewhere or abroad and now wish to celebrate that with a larger gathering of friends and family. Perhaps the place you wish to celebrate isn't licensed. Whatever the reason, we are here to help you plan the occasion that works for you.

You can choose wherever in our Borough you want this to take place. So long as the venue is suitable, our registrars can attend and conduct the ceremony of your choice. No legal preliminaries are required, so you can hold this event as soon as you choose.



These can also be combined with a legal ceremony too, either on the same day or at a different time.

You can personalise the ceremony as you wish and include traditional elements such as being escorted up the aisle, exchanging rings, sharing vows and including music and readings. If you choose, you can sign your commemorative certificate along with witnesses and have this presented to you. We will chat through with you how you would like your special ceremony to be.

Renewal of Vows

Your ceremony could be a celebration of a special milestone or anniversary in your relationship, or a celebration of overcoming a difficult time in your lives. Perhaps you didn't like the way you did it the first time and want to have the celebration of your dreams together! Whatever the reason, we can guide you through a wonderful celebration.

No legal preliminaries are required, so you can time this event as soon as you choose, and it can take place anywhere that works for you. This type of ceremony can also be personalised as you wish and include elements such as being escorted up the aisle, exchanging rings, sharing vows and including music and readings.

If you choose, you can sign your commemorative certificate along with witnesses and have this presented to you.

We will work with you to make sure your continued commitment to each other is celebrated in the special way it deserves.



Information about Religious Ceremonies

If you are marrying in the Church of England, the usual process is to arrange this with the vicar and your legal preliminaries will take place in the form of your banns being read.

You will only need to present yourselves at your local Register Office to give notice of your intent to marry if either of you is a foreign national and subject to immigration control. If you are marrying in any other Church or religious premises authorised for marriage, you will need to give notice of your intent to marry, in the same way as outlined on page 11 and 12.

If you have been married in a religious ceremony that does not hold legal status in the UK, please contact us to arrange a legal marriage ceremony. This can be as simple as you choose.

All Church and other legal religious marriages in our district are registered at our Register Office after the event has taken place. Please email us at registrars@wokingham.gov.uk to order your certificates.

Outdoor Ceremonies

The edge of a river, a wildflower meadow, a walled garden, a vineyard, the private grounds of a rustic barn – these are just some of the amazing outdoor locations you can legally marry or form a civil partnership in the Wokingham Borough.

It is now possible to marry outdoors anywhere in the grounds of a licensed venue. If the outdoor space you have dreamt of for your ceremony is not attached to a licensed venue, please see page 16 for information about our bespoke celebration ceremonies, which we could combine with a legal ceremony at another time.



Naming and Welcoming Ceremonies

If you want to celebrate the birth of your new arrival, or welcome stepchildren or adoptive children into your family, these ceremonies provide the perfect opportunity.

This ceremony enables you to express love, care, and commitment to them in the presence of your family and friends. It is also an opportunity for supporting adults or grandparents to publicly promise to help and support your child(ren) as they grow up within our community.

Our experienced registrars will ensure your ceremony is personal and memorable. We present you with a commemorative certificate as a keepsake of the occasion.

Your ceremony can be held in our Ceremony Room, at one of our licenced venues or at a venue of your choice

Information about Marrying Abroad

Some couples decide they wish to celebrate their marriage in a ceremony abroad, but without the sometimes complex processes involved in having the legal ceremony there. In that case we would be delighted to arrange your legal marriage ceremony here with us, at the Register Office or Ceremony Room, or at one of our licensed venues, and you are then free to celebrate as you wish abroad. In this scenario, your marriage would be registered in the UK. We can keep things very simple if you wish or it may be an opportunity to invite any guests who are not able to celebrate with you abroad.

If the country in which you intend to marry requires a Certificate of No Impediment and you are a resident of the Wokingham Borough, then please contact us for an appointment. This is available to UK citizens only.

If you have already married abroad, there is no facility or requirement to register your marriage in the UK. If you married following the local law of the country, and you would have been allowed to marry by law in the UK, then your marriage should be legally recognised in the UK. If you have any doubts, then please seek legal advice.

Unfortunately, we are not able to provide advice about the legal requirements of marriage in individual countries, as you would be marrying under local marriage law. More information can be found on the government website.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I get married in the Wokingham Borough if I don't live here?

Yes you can! You can have a civil marriage wherever you choose in England or Wales, but you must both give notice in person of your intent to marry in the Register Office in the district where you live. If you live abroad but have been resident in the UK for at least 7 full days, then you can give notice.

Should I get married in a Church/religious building or have a civil ceremony?

Civil marriage is offered as an alternative to a religious marriage. For that reason, we cannot include any religious elements or readings. We are happy to hand over to someone else e.g. a minister of religion at the end of the ceremony who can guide you through a blessing.

What is the difference between a registrar wedding and a celebrant led ceremony?

The key difference between a registrar wedding and a celebrant led ceremony is that a registrar wedding is legally binding. A celebrant led ceremony, while often highly personal, does not legally marry you. With us, you get the best of both worlds. Your ceremony can be personalised and tailored to your wishes in exactly the same way as a celebrant led ceremony, while also being fully legal. When you choose us, you can relax knowing your wedding will be conducted professionally, exactly as you wish, and that you will be legally married

on the day. Your guests will witness your actual legal wedding, and you will leave the ceremony married there and then. And at the end of the ceremony you will be married and your guests will have witnessed the actual legal wedding.

If you choose us to marry you, you know you will be legally married there and then on the day.

How far ahead can I book the registrars?

You can book our services for any date in the current and the next two financial years. Our fees increase annually at the beginning of each financial year. When you book your ceremony you pay the fee that is current at the time of booking. All the information around current fees are kept updated on our website.

Where will we sign the legal documents and who can be witnesses?

The signing takes place in the ceremony room or outdoor location you have chosen in front of your friends and family. Witnesses can be anyone who understands English and what marriage/civil partnership represents. Witnesses should be 18 or older, they do not need to bring ID. They will sign the marriage or civil partnership schedule.

I had a simple marriage abroad for legal reasons but now wish to celebrate with friends and family here in the UK

We can offer a celebration ceremony. This is not legally binding and cannot contain the legal marriage vows, but we have a range of alternative suggested vows, or you can write your own. Otherwise, you can celebrate as you choose, with bridesmaids, exchanging rings, being walked down the aisle – plenty of ways to make it really special!

We need to change the date of our ceremony – is that possible?

We understand that circumstances can change. When you book, we will discuss the terms and conditions with you and send them to you in your confirmation email. You can bring your ceremony forward (assuming you have given notice already) or postpone it from the original ceremony date. There will be an administrative charge for the rebooking, plus any small increase or refund in the fees paid depending on whether you move to a date attracting a higher or lower price.

When you give notice, your documents are valid for a year, so if your new date is beyond the date you gave notice then you may need to give notice again.

Can we have drinks before or during the ceremony?

Food and drink cannot be consumed in the ceremony room/area for an hour before or during the ceremony. Of course, a drinks reception away from the ceremony room is fine and in the ceremony a glass of water to soothe a nervous dry mouth is totally acceptable.

What is the difference between a civil partnership and a marriage?

In the UK civil partnership was originally introduced as an alternative to same sex marriage. Now marriage is available to all couples, and more recently civil partnership has also been made available to opposite sex couples. So, the choice of marriage and civil partnership is available to all couples. There can be confusion between a civil marriage and a civil partnership – civil marriage is a non-religious legal marriage conducted by a registrar. A civil partnership is a legal alternative to this. Please see the information on the government website.

Please note if you are same sex couple in a civil partnership this can be changed to be a marriage if you so choose. This is because for some couples they did not have the option of marriage at the time they formed their partnership. This is therefore not an option for opposite sex couples, who must dissolve their partnership if they wish to be married.

Can I change the name in my passport to my new married name before my wedding/honeymoon?

You can apply for a passport in your partner's surname, from 3 months ahead of the ceremony, as long as you have already given notice. The new passport will be dated from the date of the ceremony and will be rescinded if the marriage or civil partnership does not take place. If you are marrying here with us at Wokingham, we are happy to complete this for you for a small fee. Please either send or email the completed form to us, we will complete our sections and then return it to you.

Why are my parents' details included on the marriage documents and certificates?

Parents appear in the online register and the certificates for ancestry reasons.

The law changed in 2021 to modernise the registration process. Previously only fathers could appear in the register. That has been changed to include mothers, step-parents (if they are or have been married to the birth/adoptive parent), and same-sex parents. Deceased parents can of course also be included. If you choose not to have a parent included for your own reasons, we will totally respect that.

I want to change my name after marriage – how does that work?

Your marriage or civil partnership will be contracted using your current legal names and these are then shown on your marriage/civil partnership certificate.

There is no requirement for either party to change their names afterwards or make an immediate decision- this is a personal decision for you both.

Your certificate is the evidence of your entitlement to use either name, or to double-barrel your names. There is no specific moment when the name changes, so you can do this in your own time e.g. when your passport expires. If you are changing to an option that is not one of your surnames, you would need to do this by a change of name deed.





What if I am nervous or emotional on the day and forget my words?

Please don't worry about a thing – nerves and excitement can play a part in your big day, but we are here to guide you through it. No need to remember a thing – just simply repeat your vows after the registrar, who will say them in bite-sized chunks... so you can relax and enjoy your special moment. We will also make sure we have tissues and encourage you to take your time if you need to compose yourself, or we can say it again, it's not a problem at all.

Do I need to bring anything on the day?

No, just yourselves! Neither you or your witnesses require any ID. You have shown that when you gave notice, and we will have all the paperwork with us.

How long does the ceremony usually last?

From the moment you enter to the time the signing is completed is usually around 30 minutes, depending on the elements you include. And then- signed, sealed, delivered!
