

Without arms or long-term loss of the use of both arms

You are eligible for a disabled bus pass if you meet one of the following criteria:

- you have both arms but are unable to use them to carry out day to day tasks
- you have a limb reduction deficiency of both arms
- you have bilateral upper limb amputation
- you have a medical condition or condition which affects the use of your arms i.e. muscular dystrophy, spinal cord injury, motor neurone disease or a condition of comparable severity

You are not eligible if you have one arm and are able to carry out day to day activities.

Proof of eligibility

If you receive Higher Rate Mobility Component of Disability Living Allowance, score minimum 8 points for moving around component of Personal Independence Payment or hold a Blue Badge please follow the guidance for 'automatic eligibility'.

Otherwise, please ask an independent medical professional to sign this form to confirm you meet the above eligibility criteria:
