

Without speech

You are eligible for a disabled bus pass if you are unable to communicate in any language i.e. you are unable to make clear basic oral requests or you are unable to ask specific questions to clarify instructions.

You are not eligible under this category if you have speech but it is slow or difficult to understand i.e. you have a severe stammer or if you cannot speak English, but you speak another language.

Proof of eligibility

Please provide one of the following with your application:

- letter from the Berkshire Sensory Needs Service confirming disability registration as a person without speech
- letter from Social Services stating you are without speech
- for a child, an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) or Statement Educational Needs (SEN)

If you score minimum 8 points for communicating verbally component of Personal Independence Payment or hold a Blue Badge please follow the guidance for 'automatic eligibility'.

Alternatively, you can ask an independent medical professional to sign this form to confirm you meet the above eligibility criteria:
