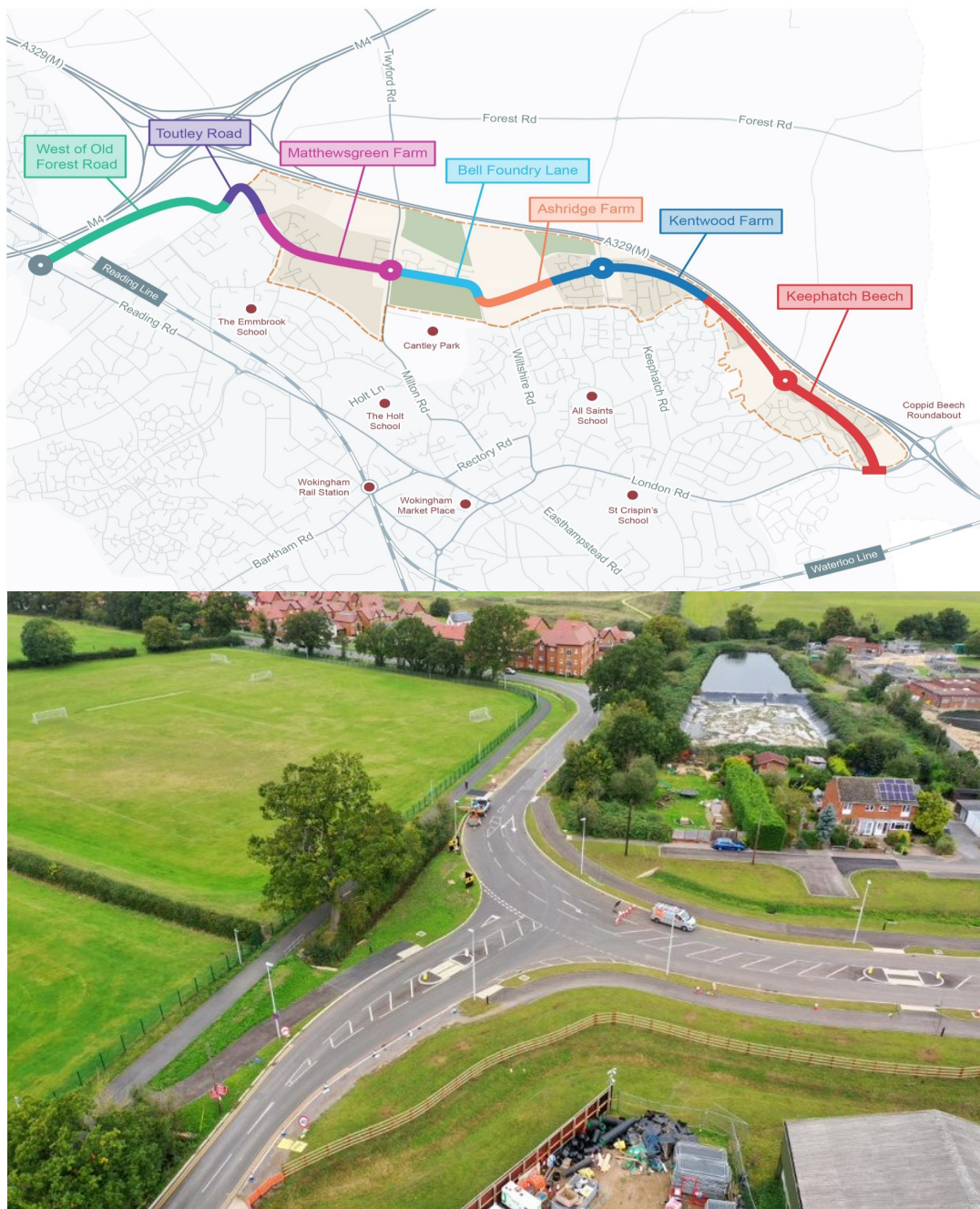


North Wokingham Distributor Road – Ashridge Farm Newsletter

» Project Overview

The Ashridge Farm project started in December 2020 and was successfully completed on 22nd October 2021. This now connects Bell Foundry Lane to Dalley Road to complete this section of the North Wokingham Distributor Road scheme, and will provide congestion relief around the north of Wokingham. The new carriageway is approximately 550 metres in length and 7.3 metres wide, with footpaths and verges at both sides. Planting of the embankments and verges to integrate the new infrastructure with the aesthetics of the area has already commenced and will continue throughout November 2021. In time, natural habitat in the area will also flourish as this was a major factor in the scheme design.

» Ashridge Stream



Works to divert the Ashridge Stream into a culvert under the route of the new road were recently completed. Nearby trees were protected to prevent damage during construction of the road and works on the two new ponds north of the road have also been completed. Not only will these take all the run off from the road, but they will also create a new habitat for local wildlife.
