



Train driver's wife

I was a train driver and was unfortunately driving a train when a woman holding an infant stood on the track in front of me while travelling at very high speed. I will never forget that awful day, the things I saw and the feeling of utter helplessness in the seconds before impact. The impact on my life was dramatic with a day not passing when I relive what happened. Counselling can never alter what happened."



## The impact of a railway suicide



"I was 15 feet away from a young lady who jumped in front of a train I was waiting for, just over a year ago at my local station. The sight of this still haunts me and it panics me every time I see a train arriving to the point I have to sit down and cover my eyes. Counselling helps but it doesn't stop my nightmares."







# Traditional approaches to suicide prevention - fencing











"We (DfT) will also be looking at ways in which we can replicate the successful work of the rail industry in other areas of the transport network such as highways and waterways"




