

» Works Overview

The Eastern Gateway will provide improved access to planned new housing within the South Wokingham major development and help to reduce congestion within the surrounding area by providing a new railway bridge to replace the current Waterloo Road level crossing. It will also ensure a high-quality corridor for pedestrians, cyclists and public transport.

In the first quarter of the year we have continued to carry out enabling works to construct the new bridge over the railway, the new roundabout and road. The main works have also continued, with piling to construct the abutments, retaining walls and wingwalls to take the new bridge. A section of Waterloo Road between the level crossing and the Oakwood outdoor bounds centre has now been closed to through traffic. This is likely to remain closed until the beginning of 2022 to allow construction of the new road and roundabout. When complete, this will offer improved access to and from London Road via Heelas Way and over the new bridge. Which when completed will offer improved access to/from London Road via William Heelas Way over the new bridge. The diversion route is via Old Wokingham Road /Peacock Lane.

>> Waterloo Road Roundabout & Carriageway Works

On 8th March, a section of Waterloo Road and Clay Lane level crossing were closed as planned. The level crossing is to remain permanently closed as the new bridge will give a safer crossing point over the Network Railway tracks. These closures have enabled the construction of the new roundabout and the 4 arms that link to it. As part of the planned works, a section of Waterloo Road will also be realigned to complete the new layout.

» Network Rail Bridge & Retaining Walls

The enabling and preparation works were completed at the end of 2020 and the main works have now commenced to build the bridge. These works comprise the construction of the North and South abutments on which the bridge beams will sit. The bridge beams are planned to be lifted into place in early May 2021 using one of the largest mobile cranes in the UK.









Installation of the reinforcement, the concrete pour to both the North & South abutment pile caps & wing walls has been completed.

» Utilities Diversion Works

The Eastern Gateway project has enabled the overhead SSE HV supply to be installed underground, replacing the previous unsightly over head cables and pylons that supported them. New BT cabling has also been installed underground for future communication infrastructure.
