What is the cost of living crisis?



The cost of things people need, like food, gas, electricity and petrol is going up quickly.



Wages and benefits are not going up as quickly.

It might be more difficult for people to pay for things.



How the cost of living going up might change things for you



You might find it harder to pay for food and other things you need.



The price of fresh and healthy food might make it difficult to eat a healthy diet.



Your weekly shopping might cost more than usual.



This means you might have to buy less.



You might have to spend less on things you like, but are not things you need.



It might cost more money to pay for gas and electricity for your home.



You might not notice this in the summer. This is because the weather is warmer and the sun stays out for longer



The energy price cap is how much money energy companies can charge for gas and electricity.



It changes four times a year. The most recent change was in July.



It will go down a little bit in July but is still a lot higher than it used to be.



You might notice energy being more expensive in winter. People use more gas and electric to keep their house warm and cook food.

The Household Support Fund



The Household Support Fund is available to people living in England.



It could help you get £100 if you are struggling to pay for:



• Energy and water bills



• Food



- Keeping your house warm

• Other essential items



Who the Household Support fund is for



You could get help from the Household Support Fund if you:

- Are vulnerable
- Cannot pay for essential items.



You do not have to be getting benefits to get the money



If you do get benefits, they will not be changed by the Household Support Fund



How to apply

You can get £100 voucher to help with food or energy
