If you are homebound or have a mobility issue which means you struggle to visit your nearest library, we can help.

## What is the Home Library Service?

We provide a home delivery service for books including large print and audio books.

A trained member of staff or volunteer will deliver items to match your reading tastes to your home every three weeks, at an agreed time. This is a **FREE** service.

## Who is eligible?

This service is provided to residents who are unable to visit their local library because of ill health, disability or because they are caring for someone.

## How do I apply?
