

## Our Public Consultation—shaping our Community Vision for Wokingham Borough

Our Community Vision for Wokingham Borough 2020-24 has been created through engagement with our residents, local schools, businesses and other stakeholders—listening to views on what needs to change or improve to ensure Wokingham borough is a great place to live, learn, work and grow and a great place to do business.

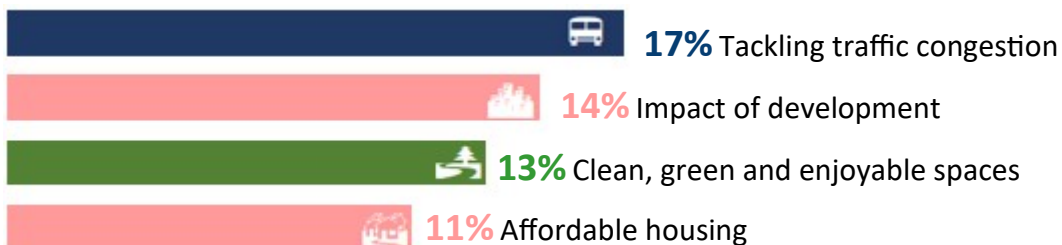
We engaged with the public on our draft Council Plan, and it's proposed key priorities, in a variety of ways:

- Leaflets distributed to all households
- Advertising on the Council website, in local news and on social media to raise awareness of our consultation.
- Online survey, which received over 1,300 comments.
- Public engagement events held across Wokingham borough, which received around 300 comments.
- Engagement with community groups, such as Wokingham CLASP—to engage with our residents with learning difficulties or disabilities.

We also engaged with our partners to consider the areas of priority and to share ideas, agree solutions and take ownership for delivering improved outcomes for Wokingham borough over the next four years.


### Your feedback, Our findings


Around 1,300 comments were received from residents via our online survey. People agreed that each priority was important and should be an area of focus however the majority of comments we received were on the following four priorities:




### Our Council—Changing the way we work for you

Through our engagement with residents, we consulted on a number of principles that will govern and guide how we work to deliver the Community Vision for Wokingham borough.

 88% of residents, who completed the online survey, agreed that we should be **Digital**; enable greater access, more efficient and customer-focussed ways to deliver services.

88% of residents also agreed we should be **Collaborative**; recognising the need for, and taking, a joint approach with residents, communities and partner organisations. 

 82% of residents also agreed we should be **Accountable**; focussing on impact and outcomes to deliver value for money and quality services.
