STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I RAY SALISBURY DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. I am and have been since 20th January 1995 (date of first registration), a director of the owners of the land known as The Northern Land and The North-East Triangle, being part of the Woodcray Manor Farm, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon shaded red.
2. On the 18th day of October 2005 I deposited with Wokingham District Council, being the appropriate Council, a Statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red shading which stated that the ways coloured brown on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as highways with vehicular status, the ways coloured orange on the said plan and on the plan accompanying is declaration had been dedicated as byway, the ways coloured green on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways, the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths, no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land shaded red on the plan accompanying this declaration other than those highways with vehicular access, bridleways, and footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.
