ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Wokingham Borough Council (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (School Road, Arborfield) Order 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council"), in order to improve road safety proposes to make the above-named Order under sections 1 (1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general effect of the order will be to prohibit motor vehicles from entering or proceeding along School Road, Arborfield in either direction, between a point 19.0 metres north-west of the centreline of Wood Lane and a point 20.5 metres north-west of that centreline. Pedal cycles, emergency services motor vehicles and local buses will be exempted from the restriction.

Documents giving more detailed particulars of the proposals, including a copy of the draft Order and a plan showing the proposed restriction, may be inspected during office hours Monday to Friday at the Wokingham Borough Council Offices, Shute End, Wokingham, Berkshire RG40 1WN from 1st August 2024.
