NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council"), in order to improve road safety proposes to make the above-named Order under sections 1(1)(a) and (c), 2(1) and 2(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Act 1984.

The general effect of the order will be to prohibit motor vehicles from entering or proceeding along Sheerlands Road in any direction from its junction with Nine Mile Ride Extension for a distance of 139 metres south of that junction.
