

Allocation breakdown for admission to Primary School 2025

The following information is based on the initial allocation on 16th April 2025 for applications received by the deadline of 15th January 2025. This information provides a statement of how places were allocated in line with the published admission arrangements.

Equal preference scheme

Places were allocated using an equal preference scheme. This arrangement allows each preference to be considered individually, taking account of the admissions criteria. Where a child can potentially be offered a place at more than one of the preferred schools the single offer is for the school ranked highest by the parent.

Where the number allocated exceeds the Published Admission Number, this could be due to multiple birth children being allocated to the same setting; a child with an EHC Plan or a looked after or previously looked after child being allocated.

For those children for whom no higher ranked preference could be offered, the designated area school (if there are places available) or the most accessible school with places is provisionally allocated, are referred to as Diverts in the table.

Oversubscription criteria

The oversubscription criteria published in this document are summaries of schools' published oversubscription criteria.




Wokingham LA student preference summary

The chart shows the breakdown of applicants who received their first, second, third or fourth preference school and those who were not offered a preferred school. 90% first preference. 7.2% second preference. 1.4% third preference. 0.2% fourth preference and 1.1% not offered a preferred school.

Unsuccessful applications


21 children were unsuccessful in their application for a preferred school. These children were allocated to either their designated area school or most accessible Wokingham school with places available.

The following charts seek to demonstrate factors that will have resulted in this outcome. Please note that some addresses will have more than one designated area Primary or Infant school.




Designated area school(s) included as a preference

This chart shows that 5 out of 21 applicants who were unsuccessful in their application for a preferred school included all their designated area schools as preferences and 19 did not include all their designated schools as preferences.



All nearest schools included as a preference

This chart shows that 2 out of 21 applicants who were unsuccessful in their application for a preferred school included all their nearest schools as preferences and 19 did not include all their nearest schools as preferences.



Number of preferences

This chart shows the number of preferences per application for applicants who were unsuccessful in their application for a preferred school. 7 had one preference, 7 had two preferences, 4 had three preferences and 3 had four preferences.

Appendix A

The following oversubscription criteria, in order of priority, will be applied when a community or voluntary controlled school receives more preferences than places available.

- a. 'Looked after' children or children who were 'looked after', but ceased to be so because they were adopted or became subject to a residence order or special guardianship order (previous 'looked-after' children)
- b. Families who have exceptional medical or social needs as the grounds for their admission to a particular school
- c. In the case of a junior school, children who have attended an infant school with close links with the school. Siblings attending a school nursery cannot be considered. At the initial allocation, when a parent is applying for a Reception place at an infant school that has both a feeder and a sibling link to a junior school and that child has a sibling currently attending Year 2 of the infant school but who will have left by the time the younger child starts, the Reception applicant will be considered under the sibling criterion as part of the initial allocation. This is because, due to the feeder link, they will be expected to still have a sibling at the linked junior school at the time of admission.

- d. Children whose permanent home address is **inside** the schools' designated area and who has a sibling at the school at the time of application, who is expected to be attending the school when the child will enter the school.
- e. Children whose permanent home address is in the school's designated area
- f. Children whose permanent home address is **outside** the schools' designated area and who has a sibling at the school at the time of application, who is expected to be attending the school when the child will enter the school.
