WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (CHURCH LANE, ARBORFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council, as the Local Traffic Authority in exercise of its powers under **Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** (as amended), and **after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act**, Wokingham Borough Council proposes to make the following Order:-

The effect of the new Order will be to introduce a prohibition of motor vehicles at the following location:

Church Lane Arborfield between a point 360 metres west of its junction with Sindlesham Road and a point 710 metres north-east of its junction with Reading Road. (emergency vehicle access will be maintained).

Persons wishing to object to or make other representations with regard to these proposals must do so in writing, stating the grounds on which they are made.

The draft Order, Statement of Reasons and plans may be inspected during office hours Monday to Friday at the Wokingham Borough Council Offices, Shute End, Wokingham, Berkshire RG40 1WN from 24th April 2025.
