**WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL
(TOUTLEY ROAD AND LONGDON ROAD, WINNERSH) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council has made the above-named Order under Section 84(1)(a) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order is to introduce a 40mph speed limit on the following roads in Winnersh:

- Toutley Road — From a point approximately 50 metres north of its junction with the A329 roundabout north-eastwards to a point approximately 20 metres southwest of the junction with Old Forest Road, a total distance of approximately 740 metres.
- Longdon Road — From a point approximately 20 metres west of its junction with the A329 roundabout westwards to a point approximately 20 metres east of its junction with Kings Street Lane, a total distance of approximately 590 metres.

The Order will come into operation on **30th June 2025**.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
