## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

### **WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, WOKINGHAM BOROUGH) (30mph SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 81, 82, 84, and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and of all other enabling powers, has made the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order would be to introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following roads or parts of roads in Wokingham Borough:

- A329 Reading Road, Winnersh
- A329 Reading Road, Wokingham
- A329 London Road, Wokingham
- Hollow Lane, Shinfield
- Bearwood Road, Barkham
- A327 Arborfield Road
- A327 Reading Road, Finchampstead
- New Mill Road, Finchampstead
- Park Lane, Finchampstead

The Order will come into operation on **30th June 2025**.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
