### **WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2023 (AMENDMENT NO. 1A) ORDER 2024**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of the power conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the above named Order on 22 April 2024, which will come into force on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2024 and may be cited as the Wokingham Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 (Amendment No. 1A) Order 2024.

The general effect of this Order will be to revoke the Wokingham Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2024 made on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2024 in its entirety. This Order will amend the Wokingham Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 ("the Order of 2023") by inserting revised Plans relating to parking changes, waiting restrictions and sections of existing restrictions into the Order of 2023.

Any person wishing to question the validity of this Order or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that this Order is not within the relevant powers or that any of the relevant requirements or regulations made hereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, make an application for that purpose to the High Court.
