NOTICE OF MAKING

**WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL
(BEARWOOD ROAD, WINNERSH)
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 81 and 82 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and of all other enabling powers, has made the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order would be to introduce a 30mph speed limit on part of Bearwood Road, Winnersh. This section of Bearwood Road will become a restricted road under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, by virtue of the presence of a system of street lighting, and no further speed limit signage will be required except terminal signs where the restricted road status begins/ends.

The Order will come into effect on **25th August 2025**.

A copy of the Order, relevant plans, and statement of reasons are available for inspection during office hours Monday to Friday at the Wokingham Borough Council Offices, Shute End, Wokingham, Berkshire RG40 1BN.
