NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (POUND LANE, SONNING) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act. The effect of this proposed order is to extend the existing 20 miles per hour speed limit on Pound Lane, Sonning by a further approximately 105 metres south-eastwards, thereby reducing the existing 30mph restricted road limit accordingly.

Schedule:

From the current 20mph speed limit terminal point located approximately 15 metres north-westwards of Little Glebe, extending southeast-wards for a distance of approximately 105 metres.
