NOTICE OF MAKING

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2023 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1,2,3,4,5,32,35,45,46,49,53,124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act of 1984"), Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order. The Order will come into force on **28th July 2025**.

The general effect of the Amendment Order will be to introduce parking changes, new waiting restrictions or amend sections of existing restrictions in parts of the following roads:

ROAD NAME	SCHEME DESCRIPTION
Shepherd's House Lane, Earley	To stop obstructive parking and enable easy access for vehicles
Blackthorn Close, Earley	To stop vehicles blocking entrance to allotments
Mays Lane, Earley	To improve driver visibility
Dunaways Close, Earley	School pick up and drop off blocking carriageway
Fairwater Drive, Woodley	To aid visibility for the informal crossing point
Rushey Way/Toseland Way, Earley	Junction protection
Haddon Drive/Rowan Drive, Woodley	Junction protection
Haddon Drive/Rowan Drive, Woodley	To extend DY to protect junction and prevent indiscriminate parking
Rushey Way/Toseland Way, Earley	Junction protection
Mill Lane, Earley	To prevent school, pick up and drop off blocking access

Greenacres Avenue, Winnersh	Junction protection
Colleton Drive, Twyford	Junction protection
Colleton Drive, Twyford	Junction protection
Caroline Drive, Wokingham	To restrict commuter parking
Murray Road, Wokingham	To prevent school, pick up and drop off blocking access and to help with traffic flow
Fishponds Road, Wokingham	To help access for HGV's
Molly Millars Lane, Wokingham	Restrictions amended for new pedestrian crossing
St Helier Close, Wokingham	To enable easy access for vehicles during school pick up and drop off times
Hart Dyke Close, Wokingham	Junction protection
London Road and School Road, Wokingham	To aid visibility and traffic flow into town (o/s No's 75-105 London Road) and School Keep Clear timings changed for improved safety benefits
Goodchild Road and Easthampstead Road, Wokingham	School Keep Clear timings changed for improved safety benefits
London Road and Seaford Road, Wokingham	To aid visibility and traffic flow into town (o/s No's 75-105 London Road) and to aid visibility (o/s No's 160-162 London Road). School Keep Clear timings changed for improved safety benefits on Seaford Road.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the making of the Order, that person may, within 6 weeks of the date of the making of the Order, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
