## **WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL**

## (CHURCH LANE, ARBORFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council"), in order to improve road safety proposes to make the above-named Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will seek to prohibit motor vehicles from entering or proceeding between a point 360 metres west of its junction with Sindlesham Road and a point 710 metres north-east of its junction with Reading Road. (emergency vehicle access will be maintained).

The Order will come into effect on 27th October 2025
