NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council"), in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32,35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and all other regulations and orders mad under the 2004 Act and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act has made the above named order.

The Order will come into effect on **09**th **October 2025** to:

- 1. Add Aviation Car Park (Mohawk Way, Woodley, Reading RG5 4UE) as a designated car park within the Council's off-street parking places.
- **2. Allow a free vend ticket period of up to 15 minutes** at Aviation Car Park, consistent with existing provisions at Dinton Pastures Country Park (Activity Centre).
- 3. Make other minor amendments consequential to the above changes.
