NOTICE OF MAKING

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

(Various Off-Street Borough Car Parks) (Civil Parking Enforcement) Order 2023 (Amendment No. 6) Order 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35, 35A, 35C and 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act has made the above named order.

Schedule:

The effect of the Order will be to amend The Wokingham Borough Council (Various Off-Street Borough Car Parks) (Civil Parking Enforcement) Order 2023 by:

- 1. Removing** from the list of parking places a defined section of the service area within Carnival Multi-Storey Car Park, Wellington Road, Wokingham RG40 2AF, in order to facilitate redevelopment works.
- 2. Adding** a new section of service area within Carnival Multi-Storey Car Park to the list of parking places, to replace the area removed and provide continued access and parking management.
- 3. Removing Elms Walk Service Area**, Elms Road, Wokingham RG40 2FE, from the list of parking places contained within that Order

The Order will come into effect on **5 February 2026**.
