NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

**WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL
GRAZELEY VARIOUS (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202***

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, proposes to make an Order introducing a 30mph speed limit on the roads and lengths specified in Schedule 1.

Extents of proposed 30mph speed limit:

- **Lambwood Hill** – From a point 30 metres north-east of its junction with Pump Lane, north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 250 metres, to its junction with Grazeley Road
- **Grazeley Road** – From its junction with Mortimer Road, southwards for a distance of approximately 145 metres.
- **MereOak Lane** - From its junction with Grazeley Green Road, north-east wards for a distance of 85 metres.
- **Grazeley Green Road** – From its junction with MereOak Lane, north-westwards for a distance of approximately 50 metres.
- **Church Lane** - Its entirety.
- **Mortimer Road** – Its entirety.
- **Bloomfield Hatch Lane** – Its entirety

The purpose of the proposed Order is to reduce traffic speeds and improve safety for all road users in this predominantly residential area, which forms part of a strategic active travel corridor.
