NOTICE OF MAKING

**WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (CULVER LANE AND PALMERSTONE ROAD,
EARLEY) (20 MPH ZONE) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections **82(2)(a), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2)** and **Part IV of Schedule 9** to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

Introduce a 20mph zone on the following lengths of road:

- **Culver Lane, Earley**, from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Palmerstone Road for a distance of approximately 250 metres in a westerly direction.
- **Palmerstone Road, Earley**, for its entire length.

The Order will come into effect on **31st December 2026**.
