NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (SANDFORD LANE, HURST & WOODLEY) (3 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL, as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (4), 3(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and all other enabling powers, after the consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act 1984.

The general effect of the Order will be to introduce the following restriction.

3 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION: No person shall cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle in excess of 3 tonnes maximum gross weight to proceed along Sandford Lane, Woodley approximately 940 metres eastwards at its junction with Mohawk Way and on to Sandford Lane, Hurst approximately 454 metres westwards of its junction with Davis Street.
