



BIGGS LANE, ARBORFIELD PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, proposes to establish a Zebra Crossing at the following location:

Biggs Lane, Arborfield

The proposed Zebra Crossing will be located:

Current informal crossing point next to the Biggs Lane and Venning Road junction, extending for approximately 30 metres in each direction.

The proposed Zebra Crossing would make it safer for pedestrians and cyclists crossing this busy road, especially in peak traffic times. A pedestrian survey was undertaken and indicated many movements across this road, given the high volume of traffic and the character of the road, it is considered appropriate to propose a Zebra Crossing at this location.
