



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 Notice of Proposal

Wokingham Borough Council (Bus Lanes) Order 20**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council, as the Local Traffic Authority, in exercise of its powers under **Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as the "1984 Act"), the Transport Act 2000, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers, and **after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act**, proposes to make the above named Order:-

The general nature and effect of the Order will be to introduce bus lanes on London Road at the following locations:

- a) London Road, Earley, Reading south-east side of the westbound carriageway, from a point 3m northeast of the common boundary of Nos. 234 and 236 London Road south-westwards for a distance of 101.5m.
- b) London Road, Earley, Reading south-east side, between the A3290 southbound entry slip road and the A3290 northbound exit slip road.
