



WOODLANDS AVENUE AND CHURCH ROAD, WOODLEY PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSINGS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, proposes to establish two Zebra Crossings at the following location:

Woodlands Avenue and Church Road, Woodley.

The two proposed Zebra Crossings will be located:

Approximately 20 metres from the roundabout on both Woodlands Avenue and Church Road, Woodley.

The proposed Zebra Crossings would make it safer for pedestrians and cyclists crossing this busy road, especially in peak traffic times. A pedestrian survey was undertaken and indicated many movements across this road, given the high volume of traffic and the character of the road, it is considered appropriate to propose a Zebra Crossing at this location.
