**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**(WOODLANDS AVENUE AND FAIRWATER DRIVE, WOODLEY)  
(EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING) SECTION 6 ORDER 2026**

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

This Traffic Regulation Order forms part of the Woodley to Reading Active Travel Route, which aims to create a safer and more attractive walking and cycling link between Woodley town centre and the Reading Borough boundary at Palmer Park.

The proposed restrictions are intended to support the safe operation of the route and improve conditions for all road users, particularly pedestrians and cyclists.

Recognising the level of local interest in the scheme, the Council has considered the potential impacts but also wishes to gather feedback from those who use these roads regularly. The restrictions are therefore being introduced through an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order (ETRO).

Subject to weather conditions, the road markings will be installed on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2026. A six month consultation period will run alongside the experimental measures, during which the Council will monitor how the changes operate in practice. Residents, businesses and road users will be able to submit comments and feedback at any time during this period, which will be taken into account when deciding whether the measures should be made permanent, amended, or removed.

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
